

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE TENDER FOR OPERATION OF BATTERY OPERATED VEHICLES (BOVs) IN NANDANKANAN ZOOLOGICAL PARK AND BOTANICAL GARDEN.

- 1) Sealed tender in prescribed form are invited by the Deputy Director, Nandankanan Zoological Park, Barang from individuals, agency, company, transport and tour operators for operation of Battery Operated Vehicles (BOVs) in Nandankanan Zoological Park and Botanical Garden for movement of visitors.
- 2) Tender should be addressed to the Deputy Director, Nandankanan Zoological Park, Post – Barang – 754 005, Dist- Khurda clearly superscribing on the top of the sealed envelope “**operation of Battery Operated Vehicles (BOVs) in Nandankanan Zoological Park and Botanical Garden**”.
- 3) Last date of submission of tender : 09.06.2009 Time : 5.00 P.M.
Opening of tender papers : 10.06.2009 Time : 11.30A.M

The tenders will be opened in the office of the Deputy Director, Nandankanan Zoological Park in the presence of the tenderers or their authorized representatives.

Unsealed tenders will not be accepted.

- 4) The minimum bid amount for operation of BOVs is fixed at Rs. 3.00 lakhs (Rupees three lakhs) only per annum. The tenderer may offer his price above the minimum amount as fixed above.. The offer will be written in the tender paper in figures as well as in words.
- 5) The tender paper will accompany the following documents.
 - a) Latest pass port size photograph of the tenderer – 1 No.
 - b) Proof of identity of the tenderer (Voter I.Card/Pan card).
 - c) Proof of residential address (copy of telephone/electric bill/copy of bank pass book with latest transaction/copy of driving license).
 - d) Income tax clearance certificate for the last 5 years .
 - e) Latest VAT clearance certificate.
 - f) Proof of registration with appropriate authority as a service provider.
 - g) Business turn over during the past 5 years with audit report.
 - h) EMD @ 1% of the bid amount in shape of bank draft drawn on any nationalized bank in favor of the Deputy Director, Nandankanan Zoological Park payable at Bhubaneswar.
- 6) The period of operation would be for two years (twenty four calendar months) with effect from the date of agreement which may be renewed for further period of another one year depending upon the performance of the operator.

7) The successful tenderer shall furnish 10% of the bid amount in shape of bank draft towards security deposit for faithful performance of the contract, at the time of execution of the agreement.

8) The successful tenderer shall pay the consideration amount in 12 equal monthly installments during each calendar year. He will pay the 11 & 12 installments at the time of signing the agreement. The balance installments will be paid in first week of the succeeding month. Failure in payment of the installments will be treated as violation of the agreement and action may be taken against the tenderer thereupon.

9) The successful tenderer shall operate the BOVs inside Nandankanan Zoological Park in the designated route. The BOVs would shuttle between 10 predetermined stations. In Botanical garden the BOVs would operate in the designated route. No man power shall be provided by the Nandankanan authority for the purpose. The tenderer will operate the BOVs only during the park hours on the working days.

10) The tenderer will put to service minimum ten (10) nos. of BOVs both in Nandankanan zoo and Botanical Garden. The BOVs should be in excellent condition and each must be safe and comfortable. Depending upon the response of the visitors and the carrying capacity, more BOVs may be added to the fleet subject to prior permission from the Nandankanan authority. The tenderer would use 3 Nos. BOVs of Nandankanan Zoological Park and 2 No. BOVs of OREDA (now in operation in Nandankanan Zoological Park) along with other vehicles to be arranged by him.

11. The safety and security of the visitors would be the utmost priority and sole responsibility of the tenderer while operating the BOVs.

12. The tender will make his independent arrangement for charging the batteries to be used in the BOVs. The Park authority shall hold no responsibility on this score.

13. The ticket charges shall not exceed Rs 30 (Rupees Thirty) only, per person per trip. The tenderer shall print the tickets at his own cost.

14. The tenderer will obey the statutory provisions of Wildlife (Protection) Act & Rules. He will remain liable for any violation of the aforesaid statutory provisions.

15. The agency/ company /individual/ operator/firm with experience in operation of BOVs in other institutions will be given preference.

16. Preference would be given to the agency/company/individual/operator/firm having annual turn of over Rs. 50 lakhs (Rupees fifty lakhs) only per year.

17. Any difference or dispute arising between the parties shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the courts at Bhubaneswar in the State of Orissa and nowhere else.

18. The Nandankanan authority does not bind itself to accept the highest tender and reserves to reject or partially accept any or all of the tenders received without assigning any reason thereof.
